
At Hotel Brenzone, we celebrate the art of imbibing by serving only the best spirits, including the grappas of the Marzadro Distillery, which you can purchase on site.

As a digestive or simply for pleasure, taste Diciot-

to Lune. An aged grappa, it has an intense and aromatic scent obtained from the distillation of 5 types of Trentino grape pomace. The Giare Amarone is a grappa with an enveloping taste and fine, decisive notes. The Olia del Garda

is an infusion of olives in grappa with a fruity structure that celebrates the Garda area. Luz Gin is a fresh and aromatic distillate created by Leonardo Veronesi, Pietro's brother, from 9 typical botanicals of Trentino.

THE GRAND TOUR OF MONTE BALDO

Between woods and mule tracks overlooking the lake

With its unique landscape that includes Mediterranean landscapes as well as alpine scenery, Monte Baldo offers an infinite number of tours you can take on foot or by mountain bike. Paths that branch out into the woods and then offer an incredible view from above on Lake Garda, grassy lawns that seem to continue all the way to the lakeshore, and ancient mule tracks are just some of the paths

you can explore. Among the possible routes, we recommend a tour that starts and ends in Brenzone. After reaching Castelletto, you arrive at San Zeno di Montagna along a state road that continues on the left. Along this stretch, a panoramic stop at the first big curve above the hamlet of Fasor is a must. The view of the lake will accompany you along the successive stages that go through the fascinating villages of Caprino - summer residence of the Verona nobility -, Spiazzi - home of the Sanctuary of the Madonna della Corona -, Novezzina with its botanical garden and Torbole. In summer, the air smells of Mediterranean aromas, in spring the characteristic local flora manifests itself in all its beauty, while in autumn the landscape is coloured with shades that range from gold to brilliant red.



Known as Hortus Europae (the garden of Europe), Monte Baldo has a completely unique type of vegetation. The climatic influence of the lake on altitude allows the coexistence of different natural environments and a wide variety of species. The Mediterranean scrub alternates with alpine pastures and rocky surfaces, an extremely varied landscape that hosts orchids, edelweiss, red lilies, wild peonies...

THE BOTANICAL GARDEN OF NOVEZZINA

A botanical treasure trove

In 1989, in Novezzina, at an altitude of 1232 m above sea level, the Comunità Montana del Baldo created a botanical garden, which covers about 20,000 m². In this high-altitude garden hundreds of native species of the territory were collected and micro-environments and local ecosystems have

been recreated. Walking among the rocks or in the beech undergrowth, you can admire the rare isolated flora that survived during the ice age. The plants and flowers of Monte Baldo, like the different varieties of orchids, are marked with information cards so the visit can become a botanical study.



CAPRINO VERONESE: A CENTRE OF NOBLE LIFE

A place and its time line

The history of Caprino Veronese is complex and shows traces of every era that has passed through. Entering the Republic of Venice at the beginning of the fifteenth century, during the four centuries of domination, noble families divided and purchased the territory. The numerous

villas that are still visible today confirm their presence. At the end of the 18th century, still under the Venetian Republic, the town experienced an important building renaissance that allowed it to pass from a simple hamlet to a village. This change resulted in significant

commercial development and the establishment of a weekly market in 1786. In this era of continuous growth, the period of the unification of Italy is the most prosperous moment for the town. Caprino Veronese is also world-renowned for its important marble extraction activity.

Since 1786, every Saturday the streets of Caprino come alive with stalls, products and people. The weekly market is still one of the most heartfelt traditions of the Verona area. The itinerant stalls are an important opportunity for the sellers, a permanent appointment for the inhabitants of the place and a fascinating way for tourists to discover a area in its most authentic expres-





VILLA CARLOTTI, FROM HOUSE TO TOWN HALL

The symbol of Caprino Veronese

Caprino Veronese and built on the foundations of a rural house from the 1400s, the villa became the property of the Carlotti family in 1601, after having been home to the Vimercato family. Subsequently, the structure undergoes several extension and restructuring works. The building was completed in 1632 and the garden with statues was created in 1635 to celebrate the title of marquises obtained by the Carlotti

Located in the centre of family. Further important enlargements continued and in 1682, the villa was classified as a palace. The noble family remained as owners until 1920, the year that sanctioned the passage to the Municipality, which on its turn became the actual owner in 1937 and which, in 1952, transferred its headquarters to this dwelling.

There is a three-way division of the building: the main sector, which is the owner's residence, the horizontal block, which

shares the neo-romantic exterior decorations, and the third part, a single floor intended for service personnel. The elegant architectural forms and the interior pictorial decorations are highlighted in an original and eccentric room, known as the "Room of Dreams". The vaulted ceiling welcomes characters with oriental clothes, birds, monkeys, carriages, images on a white background that tradition narrates as the dreams of Marquis Carlotti.



THE MADONNA **DELLA CORONA SANCTUARY**

Art, religion and landscape

The Madonna della Corona Sanctuary, built sheer above the Adige Valley at 774 meters above sea level, is located on the border between Caprino Veronese and Ferrara di Monte Baldo. The building was a hermitage in the spect certain traditions of fifteenth century and in 1625 becomes a sanctuary, thanks to the decision of the Knights of Malta to rebuild the church inaugurated in 1530 and

completed in 1680. Inside, there is the Scala Santa, a reproduction of the Roman staircase found near the Basilica of San Giovanni in Laterano. In order to walk the steps of this monument, it is necessary to rethe faithful people. Along the right wall, there is a treasure of historical and artistic significance: 167 ex-votos (votive offerings) of various sizes, the oldest of which dates back to 1547. A destination for thousands of pilgrims and devotees, as well as a famous tourist resort, the sanctuary is reached via a scenic route called the Sentiero della Speranza. Crossing the 2.5 km road, which houses the the Signs of the Cross, you can admire the valley, the Gruppo del Sengio, Ponte del Tiglio and the Grotta della Pietà.





A RESTAURANT OVERLOOKING THE LAKE

The historic flavours of Garda

A territory is also known through its culinary traditions; perhaps the most pleasant way to explore a place. In our restaurant, Brenzone tells its story starting from its name: Al Vapor. The dining room and veranda overlook the characteristic pier where the fa-

mous steamboat arrived at the beginning of the twentieth century. In this context, scenic beauty is one of the secret ingredients. We serve dishes that give substance to the authenticity and regional flavours as well as Mediterranean ones. The local extra virgin olive oil stands out as a taste enhancer, accompanied by another delicious nectar. As a pairing with the many dishes based on lake or sea fish, Pietro recommends the perfect wine from the noble regional and national vintages he has collected in the cellar.











INGREDIENTS FOR 4 PEOPLE

400 grams pasta 200 grams salmon 2 courgettes 8-10 cherry tomatoes 1 clove of garlic ½ onion Half a glass of white wine Pinch of thyme 250 grams cream **Almonds**

PREPARATION

Cut the courgettes into strips and place them in the oven at 200 ° C for approx. 20 minutes remembering to turn them halfway through cooking. Toast the flaked almonds in the oven and let them cool. Prepare a sauce of olive oil, onions and garlic and, as soon as it has browned, add the chopped salmon: sauté, add white wine and let reduce. Next, add the diced tomato and fresh thyme. Cook for a couple of minutes over high heat, add the cream and mix. Drain the bigoli and sauté in the pan with the sauce. Serve with zucchini and almonds.



Bigoli

Similar to a thick spaghetti, bigoli are a long wheat pasta, characterized by a rough and porous surface that sauces and condiments can stick to. Of Venetian origin, but also widespread in Lombardy, they represent the basis of many recipes in our restaurant that bring tradition to the table, but also flavours that come from nearby lands.


Pasta felicetti

For four generations, Pastificio Felicetti and their passion for tradition has been delivering a product to the world that is a symbol of Italian food culture. Used in the kitchen of the Hotel Brenzone, the Il Cappelli line finds its origins in the organic single grain wheat of the lands of Puglia and Basilicata, which recalls the scent of summer hay. In the tasting, soft and chewy, this pasta recalls the sweet taste of breadcrumbs enhanced with an unusual saline finish.






